No one does umami like Mat Lindsay. This celebrated Chippendale restaurant serves an innovative menu including the world-famous fermented potato bread with salmon roe and kefir, blood sausage sangas and Yamba King prawns with fermented shrimp butter.

An industry favourite, for good reason. Co-owners Andy and Sarah serve homestyle European fare in this cosy Darlinghurst spot. Don't skip the crumbed scallops or everchanging specials board.

Royal Palace Seafood Restaurant

393-399 SUSSEX ST, HAYMARKET

Our list, like any good weekend, wouldn't be complete without Yum Cha. Royal Palace Seafood is a 600-seat, three-level restaurant that takes the mango pancake.

CAFÉS & DINERS

" My all-time favourite café is Smalls Deli, in Potts Point. Ben's whole ethos is great quality food with a creative spin. There's a freshness to his sandwiches like no other – my go-to is the Al Green with cheddar, sitting on a milk crate in the sun, between the surrounding art deco apartments that line the streets.
